DAY 1

SINGAPORE → AMSTERDAM

AMSTERDAM

DAY 3

AMSTERDAM

- ❖ Volendam (Optional Tour) a fish Village town in North Holland well-known for its traditional costume and vibrant Dutch music scene.
- ❖ Giethoorn (Boat Ride included) a beautiful, idyllic village nicknamed the "Venice of the North" Experience the beauty and tranquil of this village as you go on a unique boat ride, gliding along the narrow canals and under the bridges. During your free time, feel free to explore charming village on foot - stroll past ancient thatched-roof farmhouses tread across old wooden bridges.

- ❖ Old Town to find the Rathaus, the oldest city hall building in Germany that is still in use
- ❖ The Great St. Martin Church pay a visit on your own to Mainz and set off on an orientation tour with your tour manager. Step in the Old Town to see Mainz Cathedral, Staatstheater Mainz, as well as the beautiful fountain, Marktbrunnen. You may also spend some time strolling along the Rhine River, the longest river in Germany.

DAY 5

MAINZ-HEIDELBERG-COLMAR

- Heidelberg embark on an orientation tour of this picturesque city, well-known for its romantic landscape with the towering Heidelberg Castle in the background.
- ❖ Old Town Wander through the charming alleys and squares of the town and immerse yourself in the unique ambience surrounded by history.
- Hauptstrasse this is bursting at the seams with cafes and restaurants as well as renowned branded stores and small boutiques.
- Colmar the picturesque city of Colmar situated in the heart of the idyllic Alsace region in northeastern France.

DAY 6 COLMAR-DIJON

(B/French Dinner with Wine)

- Free at leisure you may spend some time in this quaint town that looks like a scene straight out of a storybook, with its delightful house, rustic canals and lush flora and fauna.
- Old Town embark on an orientation tour along the narrow winding streets of the historic town, littered with medieval houses dating back to the 16th and 17th century.
- ❖ Petite Venise an incredibly pretty spot where unique half-timbered Alsatian houses line the waterway as it winds through the city's old fishmonger district.
- Dijon the capital city of the famous wine-making Burgundy region. Visit a winery for some winetasting as you learn more about the history of wine production and enjoy some free time explore the town centre of Dijon.

❖ La Vallee Village – this luxury shopping heaven, with 100 brand boutiques selling everything from clothes and cosmetics to shop with great buys of up to 70%discount from prominent brands like Prada, Furla, Long Champ, Gucci, no one is likely to leave empty-hand.

- Seine River / Moulin Rouge show (Optional Tour) – the World renowned "Moulin Rough" for a typical French Can-Can Revue.
